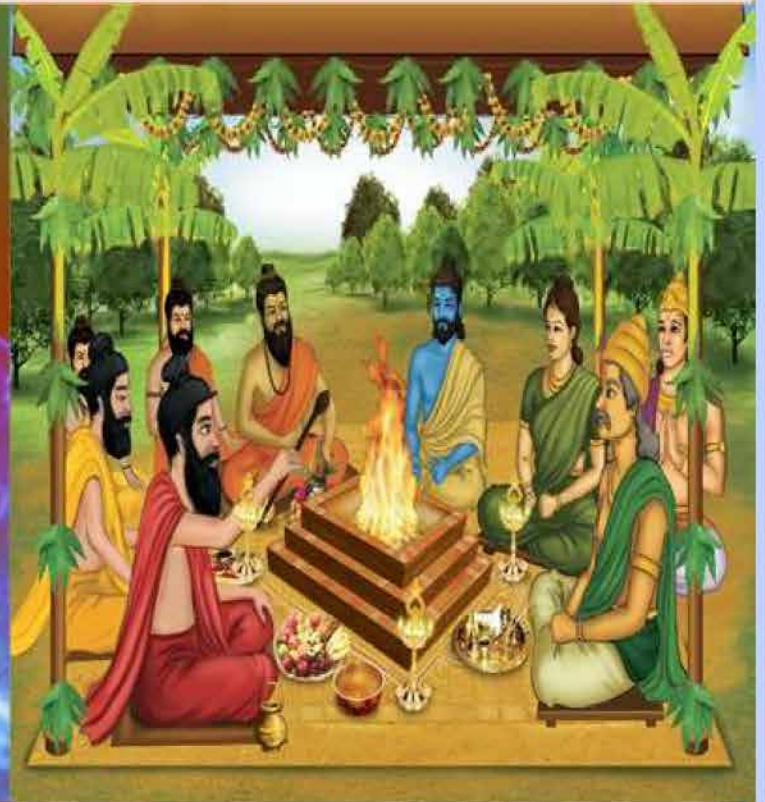

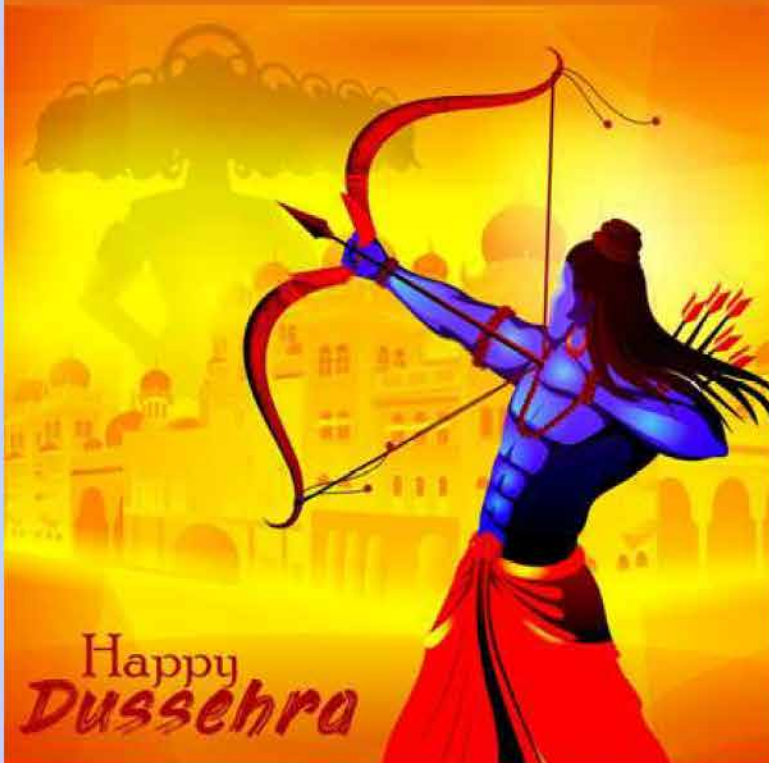

This festival is very popular amongst married Hindu women in the western and northern parts of India, primarily in Punjab, Rajasthan, Haryana, Gujarat, and Uttar Pradesh. During the Karva Chauth festival, married Hindu women dedicate the day to their husbands. Normally, women who observe this festival are called "Saubhagyavati" meaning "joyous and happy status of wifehood." The festival was emerged also as a day for celebrating autumn. Hindu married women enjoy the company and companionship of relatives and friends.

Skanda Sashti, the 6th day of the month of Aippasi, is dedicated to Lord Muruga, and commemorates the annihilation of the Asura Soora Padman. Karthikeya, the second son of Lord Shiva, younger brother of Lord Ganesha, was created from the fiery seed from Lord Shiva's third eye to vanquish the Asuras and liberate the Devas. He sports the Shakti Vel, a spear bestowed on him by his mother. He engaged the armies of Simhamukha, Surapadman and Tarakasura in a six day battle and vanquished all of them on the sixth day. Lord Muruga is called upon by other names such as Karthikeya, Kathiresa, Saravana, Subramanya, Shanmukha, Arumuga, Kumaresa, Guha, Velayudha etc.

What is Guru Peyarchi?

Guru also known as Brihaspathi (Jupiter); it is a benefic planet and is the Guru of the Devas. Lord Guru was born to the Saint Angiras, who is the son of Lord Brahma and Chiratha devi. It takes 12 years for Guru (Jupiter) to complete the full zodiac signs. In each house it stays for one year. The movement of Guru from one house to another house is called guru peyarchi 2020.

The results of Guru Peyarchi 2020

Guru is responsible for Marriage, Children, Fortune, Wealth etc. If Jupiter is in a good position like exalted or in its own house, then the native will be an influential person, will enjoy all benefits and happiness. They will do impossible things in a possible way. If Guru is not strong in one's horoscope, they will have to undergo all difficulties in life. Tulsi Vivah is the Ceremonial marriage of the Tulsi (holy basil) plant to the Hindu god Shaligram or Vishnu or to his avatar, Sri Krishna. The Tulsi wedding signifies the end of the monsoon and the beginning of the wedding season in Hinduism. Tulsi or Tulasī (Holy basil) or Vrinda is a sacred plant in Hindu belief. Hindus regard it as an earthly manifestation of the goddess Tulsi/Vrinda; she is regarded as a great worshipper of the god Vishnu. The offering of its leaves is mandatory in ritualistic worship of Vishnu and his forms like Krishna and Vithoba.

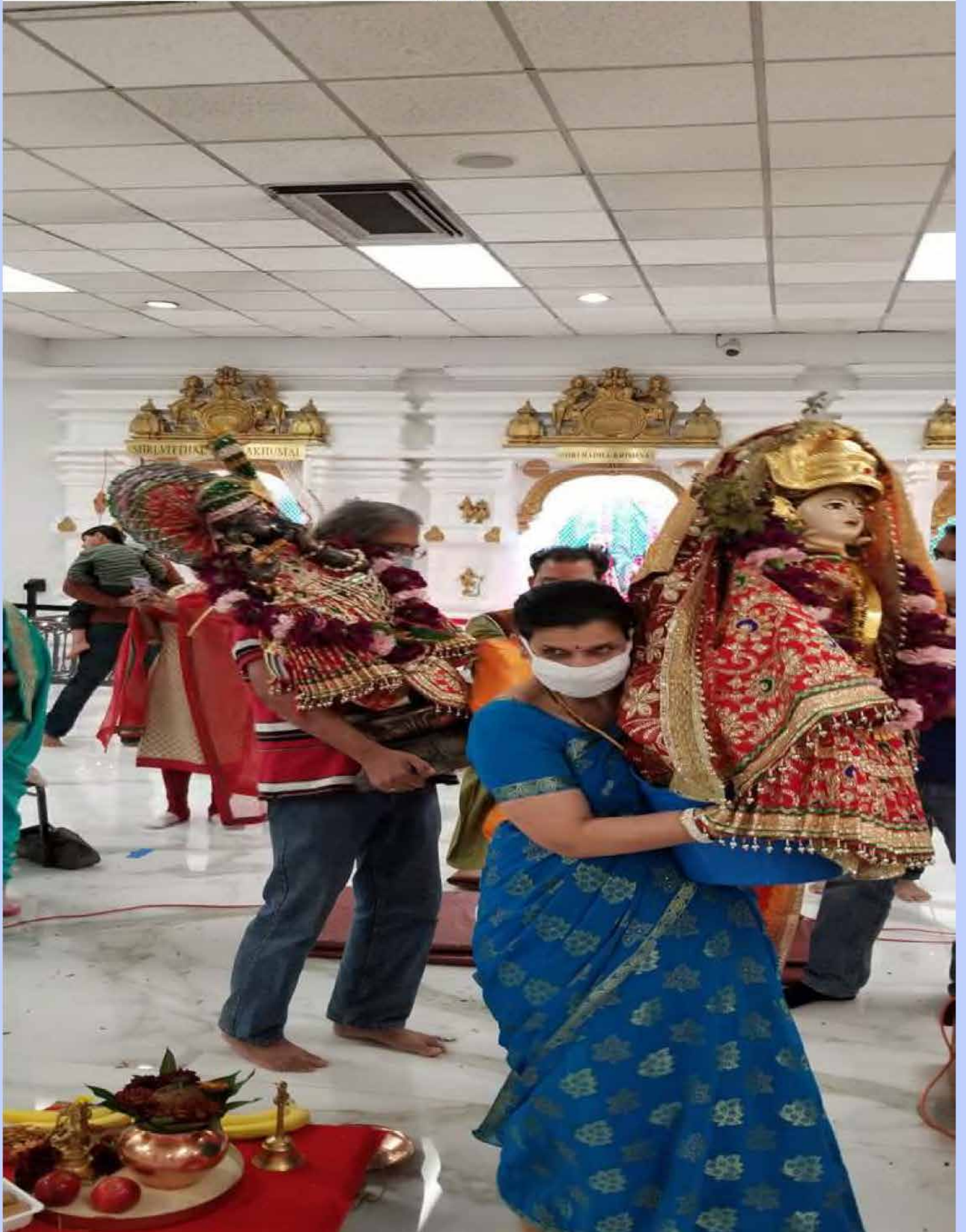

Lord Krishna had appeared as "Prabhu Jagannatha in Nagajuna form" to not only revive Arjuna's life from his son Nagajuna's attack but also to salvage Arjuna's reputation as being killed only by Lord Krishna. Surya Devata had to extend the tithi for more than a day for the Sanjivani mantra by Yamraj to work on Arjuna's revival. This was a lesson to clear Arjuna's Ego that he cannot be killed by anyone except Krishna. Lord Krishna had taken birth as Nagajuna, Arjuna's Naga son to make him realize his Ego, the error that we do as human being!

Vidya Vikas (VV) School finished a very successful all-virtual Fall semester with the end of a somewhat forgettable year due to the pandemic. Having tested the virtual model, towards the close of the school year 2019-2020, as well as with an all-Virtual Summer School, Vidya Vikas and the temple management decided to start all VV classes Virtual only.
